Shows may be adjusted at the judge's discretion based on number, type and quality of entries. There will be 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place for each show class, Grand Champion and Reserve Champion for each ram and ewe divisions and a Best of Show. Your animals will be judged using the Navajo-Churro Sheep Association's breed standard, with general observations on health and fitness of the animal. Both colored and white sheep will compete against each other in their respective classes. Lamb classes will begin the show.

Sheep show registration and entry fees will be accepted on the day of the show.

ALL ENTRANTS MUST READ AND SIGN THE FOLLOWING:

I understand that I am responsible for caring for my animals and that I must bring my own feed, shade, water buckets etc. Pens will be provided at \$4 per sheep, with 12 sheep max per pen. Pens can be divided with your own personal panels. I understand that water is available, but I will have a supply of my own water in case something happens to the water system. Camping is at my own risk. I will comply with Old Spanish Trail Arena, a Grand County Events Building, and PRCA Rodeo Grounds security and parking requirements. I will be courteous to others and practice safety in all activities.

I understand that I must maintain full control of any animals, including but not limited to exhibited sheep, pets, service animals that I bring to the event. Pet dogs are not prohibited, but not encouraged. I recognize and acknowledge that I assume full risk of any injury, property and animal damage or loss, which I may sustain as a result of my participation in the 2022 Navajo-Churro Sheep Association's Annual General Meeting.

I agree to waive and relinquish all claims I may have against Navajo-Churro Sheep Association or its agents, Board of Directors, officials, employees, volunteers, funders and all event sponsors thereof from any and all claims other parties may have resulting from injuries, damage and loss caused by me arising out of, connected with or in any way associated with the activities of the Annual Meeting. It is understood and agreed that Navajo-Churro Sheep Association or its officials, Board of Directors, employees, volunteer's, funders, hosts and agents shall not be responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any person, property or animals which is caused directly or indirectly by any reason.
